

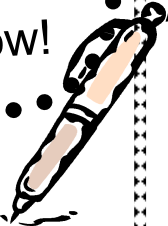

## So far in 2009...

**Building the Community-Pharmacy Partnership (BCPP) in the last 4 years has committed over £1.75 million to community-pharmacy initiatives working to *address the health needs of local communities across Northern Ireland.***

**Below is a flavour of what BCPP has been up to in 2009:**

**Awarded over 30 initiatives** to work with vulnerable groups on a range of health issues.

An example of an initiative funded is **Breakthru** in Dungannon. *Breakthru in partnership with Boots the Chemist will work to raise awareness of drug misuse and support people with drug addictions through a number of information and support sessions.*

**Trained over 30 participants** on finance.

**Held 3 group work skill training sessions** with **over 50 participants** in attendance both from the community / voluntary and pharmacist sector.

**Published** our latest edition of **Lite Bites**.

**Award Given** to Richard Garvey, Meigh Pharmacy who scooped the prestigious *Pharmacist of the Year Award* for his work with the travelling community in his BCPP project.

**Presently** we are undergoing work to complete a toolkit to help BCPP projects evaluate the health impact of their community-pharmacy initiative.
